Under the supervision of the Capital and Housing Advisor, the Sawyer ensures operation and maintenance of the portable sawmill (Transfer Station site) under the Tree to Home Project in Natoaganeg First Nation.

Responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Operate and maintain Norwood LumberPro 36HD sawmill at the Transfer Station.
- Produce rough cut 2" lumber for use in various on-site projects and to fill community orders.
- Participate in work site safety training as it relates to the small sawmill operations activities.
- Ensures safe keeping of equipment and supplies under his or her responsibilities.
- Make adjustments and minor repairs to sawmill systems.
- Responsible for overseeing maintenance of sawmill site and proper storage of processed lumber.
- Basic carpentry to build sawmill shelter and storage structures.
- May perform other duties requested by Supervisor.
