Primary Responsibilities and Duties:

- Complies with the work schedule and tasks as assigned by carpenter or housing supervisor in the completion of physical support of trade related work.
- Regularly provides support for the maintenance of housing units.
- Does minor repairs in and around housing units.
- May accompany contractors called to perform work at buildings and housing units.
- Ensures safe keeping of equipment and supplies under his or her responsibilities.
- Prioritizes working in a safe manner and following safety protocols.
- May perform other duties requested by the Housing Supervisor.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Preferred High School Diploma or equivalency. Moderate (2-5) years of work experience in the field of carpentry and/or support to construction trades.

Additional requirements:

- Must pass a criminal record check.
- Driver's license and reliable transportation is an asset
