



EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY NATOAGANEG FIRST NATION EMPLOYABILITY PROGRAM

Project Date: June 1st, 2026 – September 11th, 2026

Eligibility Criteria:

- Open to current social assistance clients, age 31+ (due to funding source)
- Must be physically able to perform the duties of the position

Employment Type: Term, full-time, 75 hours bi-weekly

Summary of Project:

The objective of the employability program is to provide participants with varied work experience, skills development, and employment coaching, to prepare them for other employment opportunities. Successful applicants will be given work assignments based on suitability. Assignments could include but are not limited to the following:

- Performing minor repairs in and around the buildings and homes
- Providing services to the elders of the community
- Safe keeping and maintenance of assigned equipment and supplies
- Grounds keeping and maintenance
- Clearing snow and ice from walkways and parking areas
- Working at the community food centre
- Setting up for community events

Additional Requirements:

As part of the Employability Program, participants will be followed by the Social Development Case Management Worker to work towards the goal of securing employment beyond the Employability Program.
